Print division: prints should be 60 to 320 square inches mounted on foam core board, preferably 16 X 20 inches. Matting and framing are optional and are disregarded in judging. On the back in the top left corner, print the title of the photo, your name and a direction arrow for up.

Digital division: images should be JPEG files 1400 pixels on the longest side, 3 entries per member. Email files to competition@oakridgecameraclub.org It would help if your file is named in the format name.theme.1.jpg. The competition chairman will acknowledge receipt of the image(s) by return email.

I missed it but Pat Postma had the following to report: *"Colby McLemore, a professional photographer in Knoxville, has a devoted fan base of former students who have taken his Lightroom courses in the UT Photographic Certificate program.
