Digital images may be submitted on CD or electronically.

If you prefer to submit on CD, you must bring the CD to the Oct 14 club meeting along with a completed entry form and entry fee.

If submitting electronically, email your images to [ccor.di.entries@gmail.com](mailto:ccor.di.entries@gmail.com) between October 4 and October 17, 2014. The entry fee should be mailed to CCOR Salon, 104 Berea Road, Oak Ridge, TN 37830 in time to be received by October 21.

Prints and fees will be accepted at the New Hope Center on October 31 (12 noon – 5:00 pm) and November 1 (10:00 am – 2:00 pm).

We need a Leader for taking the prints down and sorting them for people to pick up. The prints will be taken down on Friday morning the 21st.
