The next Camera Club of Oak Ridge meeting will feature a presentation by Stephen Wicks, the Knoxville Museum of Art's Barbara W. and Bernard E. Bernstein Curator, who will discuss the process of curating photography exhibits.

Prior to his appointment as Curator at the KMA, Mr. Wicks served as curator of collections and exhibitions at the Columbus Museum in Georgia and in a similar capacity at the Knoxville Museum of Art. He holds a master's degree in Art History and Museum Studies from Case Western Reserve University and a bachelor's degree in Art History from the University of Tennessee. During his 19-year curatorial career, he organized dozens of exhibitions devoted to contemporary art including Forest of Visions (1993); Awakening the Spirits: Art by Bessie Harvey (1998); Richard Jolley: Sculptor of Glass (2000); and New Directions in American Drawing (2006).
