Anyone who has seen Karen Jones' work (<https://karenjonesphotography.com/>) knows she is a superior photographic artist. Her images are beautiful but perhaps more importantly capture great emotion that speak volumes. Karen seems to be able to integrate both the left and right sides of her brain when she creates an image. A big part of her success comes when she captures just the right moment--the twinkle in a subject's eye or the critical split-second in an action shot. Another important component of her creative genius is her ability to process her images. She is one of those photographers who "get it right"; not too little and not too much. Just the right touch to make her statement.
