Who We Are

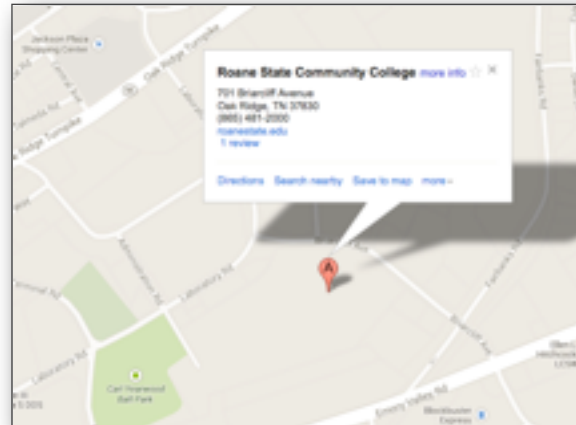
We are a group of enthusiastic photographers of all ages and levels of experience.
